Travelling to the venue

Arriving by train

Cardiff Central station is 1.12 miles from the venue, approximately a ten minute walk. Cardiff Queen Street station is 0.4 miles from the venue, less than a five minute walk.

Arriving by bus

The venue is on several bus routes. The nearest bus stop to the venue is on Fitzalan Place with routes 9, 11, 28, 29 and 30 all stopping here.

Parking

There are several parking options for this event. The car park underneath the hotel has 70 spaces and a charge of £10 per car per day. This can be paid for in the hotel reception.

There are two NCP car parks on Knox Road and Greyfriars Road, as well as a Cardiff City Council car park on Howards Place.

Catering

Lunch will be served in the hotel restaurant. Both hot and cold options will be available, and all dietary requirements will be catered for. Refreshments will be available throughout.
